The Baltic Sea Commission is aiming at a lead position in the Baltic Sea Area

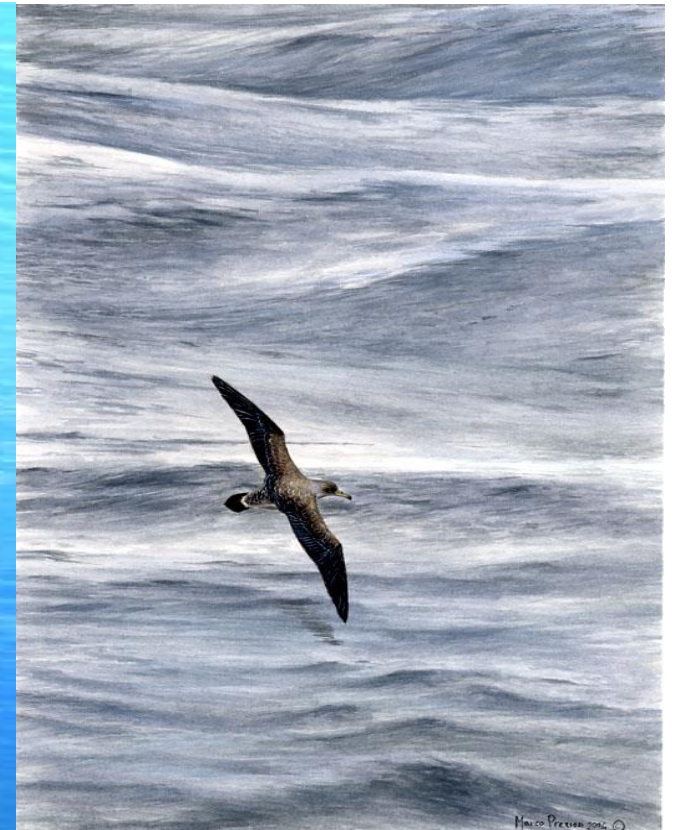
Active participation is at the top of the agenda
