Registration: Online until 04.03. via www.vm.regierung-mv.de/cpmr

Technical information: Costs for the meeting will be borne by the organisers. Travel and accommodation will have to be paid by participants. Meeting language: English.

Ferry + car via Gedser / Trelleborg and Rostock: It is recommended to book in advance. Please take check-in times into account (1h before departure for Trelleborg ferries, 30min for Gedser ferries). It takes at least 1h to travel Schwerin – Rostock Port via A14, A20, A19, depending on road conditions. Train from Kopenhagen: Schwerin – Lübeck – Kopenhagen takes approx. 5,5 h.

Plane + train: Most convenient is **Hamburg** (HAM). Take S-Bahn (underground) to Hamburg Hauptbahnhof, change there. Airport – Central station takes approx. 30min, Hamburg – Schwerin takes at least 1h. Timetable and tickets from <http://reiseauskunft.bahn.de/> (also in EN), enter "Hamburg Airport" and "Schwerin".

It is also possible to arrive at **Berlin-Tegel** (TXL). Take bus TXL to Berlin Hauptbahnhof, change there. Airport – Central station takes ~20min, Berlin – Schwerin takes at least 2h. Other connections are possible. Timetable <http://reiseauskunft.bahn.de/>, enter "TXL Berlin Airport" and "Schwerin".

Ryan Air operates one lunchtime flight Skavsta – **Lübeck** (LBC), 1h VIP transfer or rent a car.

IC trains from Hamburg stop only at Schwerin Hauptbahnhof. All RE trains stop at Schwerin Mitte + Schwerin Hauptbahnhof, some RE trains also stop at Schwerin Süd and Schwerin-Görries – please take care to get off at the right station (see map). Walk ~20 min from Hauptbahnhof or take tram #1 direction Hegelstraße (runs all 15 min, 2nd stop: Schlosblick), walk < 10 min from Schwerin Mitte.
